From our Pastor



When I crafted my submission for the church's Annual Report, secretary Joyce Cornwell reminded me that the report is a collection of what occurred in 2025. So, my final "Hopes & Dream" portion wasn't necessary. Then she suggested that we use it for my next Steeple column. Works for me!

Several ministry priorities are already being shaped for 2026.

Congregational Visioning / Shared Ministry Direction

- **January & February focus:** "What should our church's New Year's resolution be—as a congregation?"
- **Intent:** what if we create a collaborative committee to shape this work (not top-down, but shared leadership)?

Potential topics for congregational reflection include:

- **Individual faith journeys.** Our stories are varied. Why don't we share them with one another if you are comfortable doing that?
- **Worship and music styles.** You know, we can shape worship in any way that best suits us. We can maintain tradition. We can step outside the box, outside our comfort zones. Whatever we do in worship together, it is in a right spirit.
- **What do people feel is missing or needed in church?** We have just completed the first quarter of the 21st century! It is a new time. But it's okay to miss old familiar things. As we begin the *next* quarter century, what does our church need?
- **Who is missing? How do we create belonging?** Feeling an integral part of a community and contributing to something bigger makes us all feel better.
- **New activities & ministries.** Let's try new things. What's on your mind? Talk to the Deacons. Talk to me.
- **Leadership participation and ways to serve.** Serve our church. Serve our community. We already have great visibility every week with our Welcome Table feeding ministry. How else might the community see us in action?

Ecumenical Partnerships

- What if we explore collaboration with local churches and potentially launch "Theology on Tap"? Working together creates more community and relationships.

I hope I have given you some ideas that spark your interest. Let's talk!


